

But after a while I suddenly realized I get these films. I get where they are coming from, I understand the themes, and I enjoy these films. After having this class I have a deeper appreciation for French Film, and realized I can connect more with these films than those of American creation. Whenever a foreign film was released in the US I never had intentions of seeing them, but now I want to see them and see what I've been missing out on!

The student presentations were a drag, and rarely touched on anything not already discussed, but I suppose it's more an exercise for the student than a learning opportunity for those who have to sit through them.

I went into the course thinking that the films we would be discussing would be watched in class, only to find out I had to watch them outside of class. This was a little inconvenient, as I can't always go to the media center to watch them and

can't afford to have multiple streaming services to watch them all. I think that is something that should be disclosed on the course information.

Covered a variety of films within a specific genre


The discussion posts were helpful for me to organize my thoughts on the film for the in-class discussion later on in the week.


Typically, how much time per week did you spend on this course outside of class?




